# National Achievement Survey

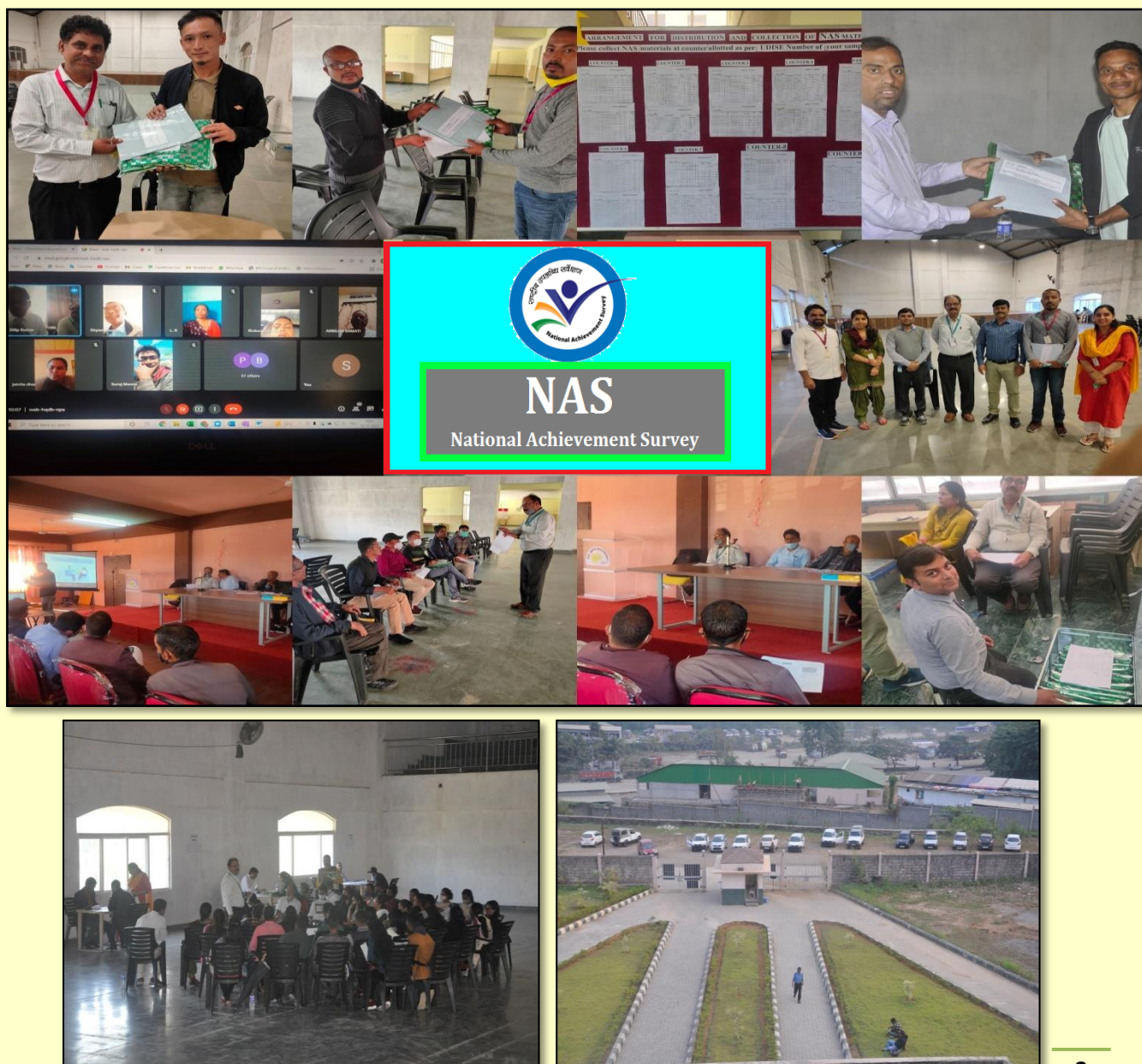
National Achievement Survey (NAS) is a nationally represented large-scale survey of students' learning undertaken by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

National Achievement Survey-2021 was scheduled on 12th November 2021. The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) has developed the Assessment Framework for gauging the competencies attained by the students vis-a-vis learning outcomes. This national level survey was conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) as Assessment Administrator for Grade 3, 5, 8 and 10 students of State Govt. schools, Govt. Aided schools; Private Unaided recognized schools and Central Government schools.

NAS findings would help diagnose learning gaps of students and determine interventions required in education policies, teaching practices and learning.

Star Public School was the Nodal Centre and custodian for 177 selected sample schools. Mr. Dilip Kumar,

Principal, was appointed as the District Level Coordinator who had to look after the entire Survey conducted in East Jaintia Hills.





# Children's Day Celebration

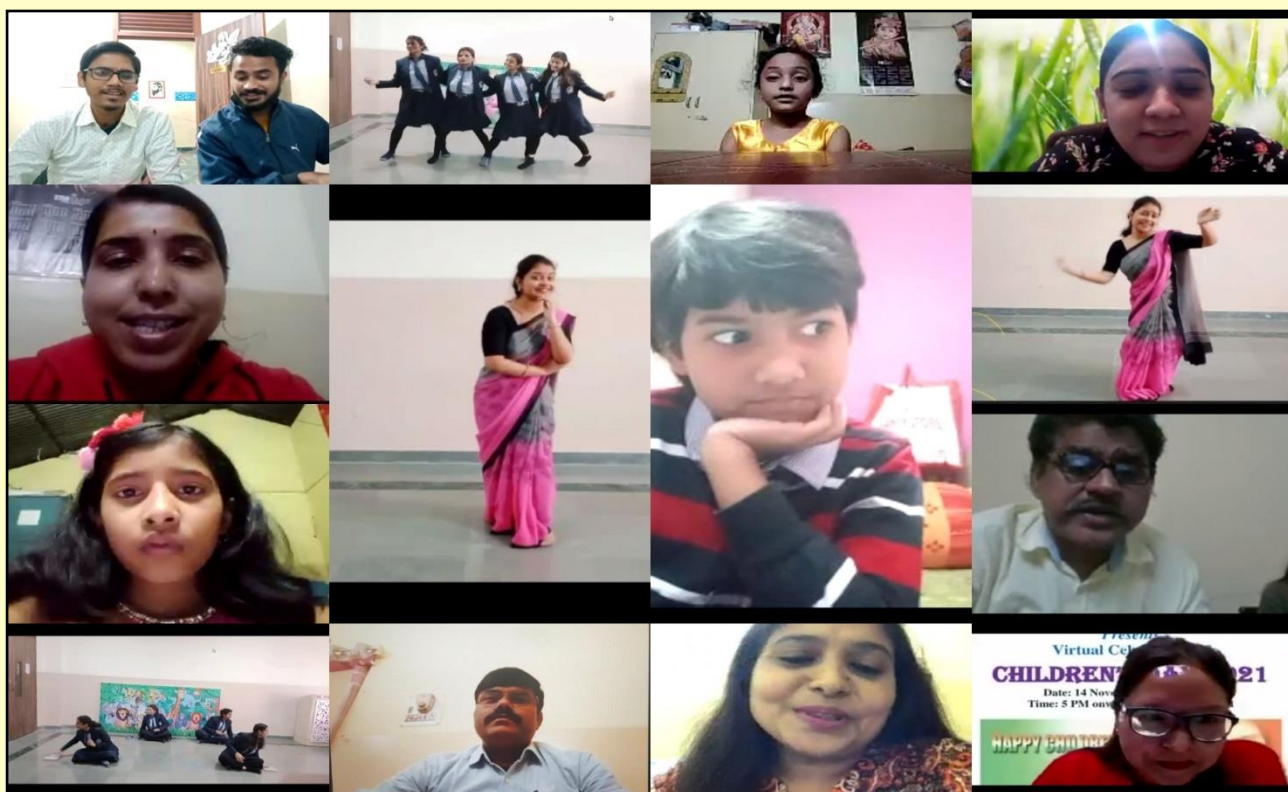
"Every child is a different kind of flower and all together makes this world a beautiful garden."

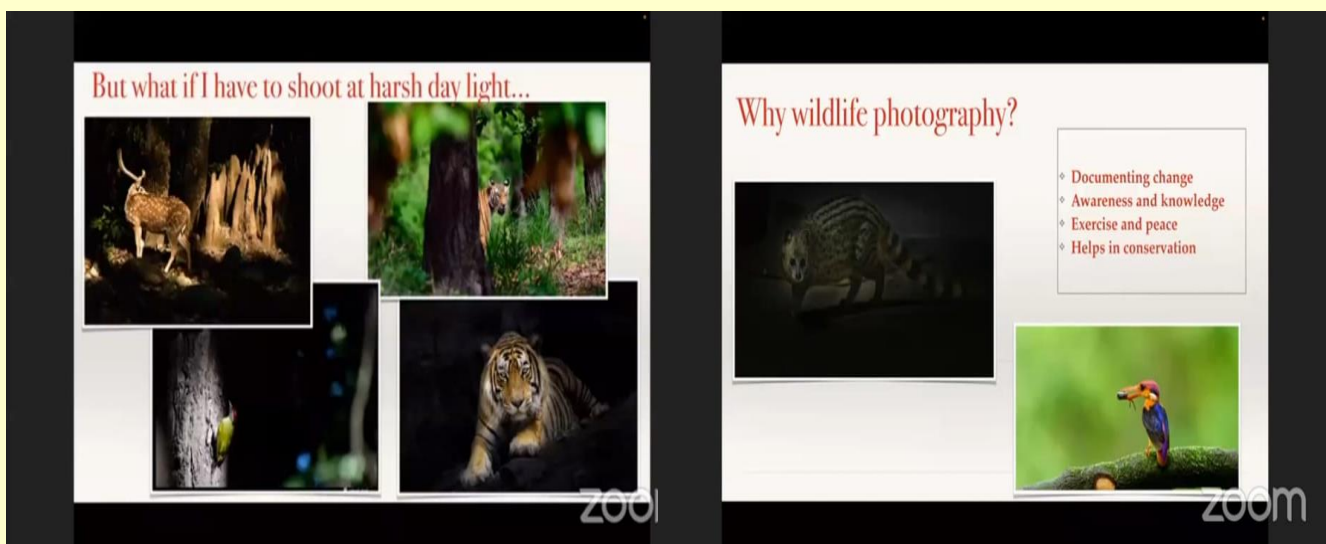




# A Ye Masterclass

A picture is a poem without words', Roman poet Horace quite rightly describes the power of images to make a mark in the minds of viewers. On 27th November, an online Master Class was arranged for the students which exhibited a wide range of his eloquent photographs on wildlife and nature. Our students had a soul-stirring experience of capturing vivid wildlife expressions in tranquil green destinations, through the camera and passion for photography by Indranil Ghosh, a Mumbai based banker (and not a professional wildlife photographer) with a deep love for nature wildlife and photography, a conservation educationist and researcher. It left an indelible mark in the minds of nature lovers. In his words, "The myriad experiences I have had egged me on to capture them in frames so that I could share their beauty with the world," The snaps have been taken at different locations across Kerala such as Sunderban Tiger Reserve, the Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary, the Periyar Tiger Reserve and the Eravikulam National Park among others. One of his personal favourites in the exhibition was 'Walking into the Twilight', a pan shot of a tiger walking in the Periyar Tiger Reserve. He uses photography as a medium to spread awareness about the urgent need for forest conservation. Through his photos, he urges Students to venture out into nature to explore its hidden charm and to savour it. Only by imbibing the power and beauty of the ecosystem that protects us, will people feel the need to conserve it."

# National Unity Day

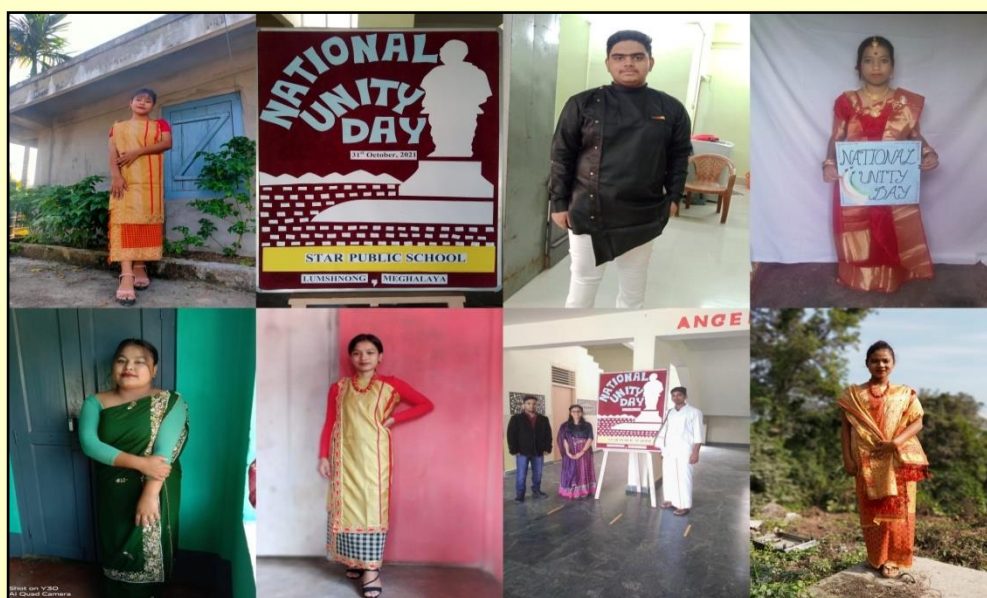
