

<u>Gandhi Jayanti</u>



The assembly was coordinated by Mr. Bijan Debnath and Mrs. Shubhangi Shandilya.




Avantika Colouring Olympiad 2021

Mr. Bijan Debnath(science faculty) has coordinated the event.














Durga Puja


















Cultural Exchange Program







A meeting was conducted for the club members on 30th October to work on communication skills of the students, so that they beam with confidence while interacting and as a public speaker.


