Gandhi Jayanti

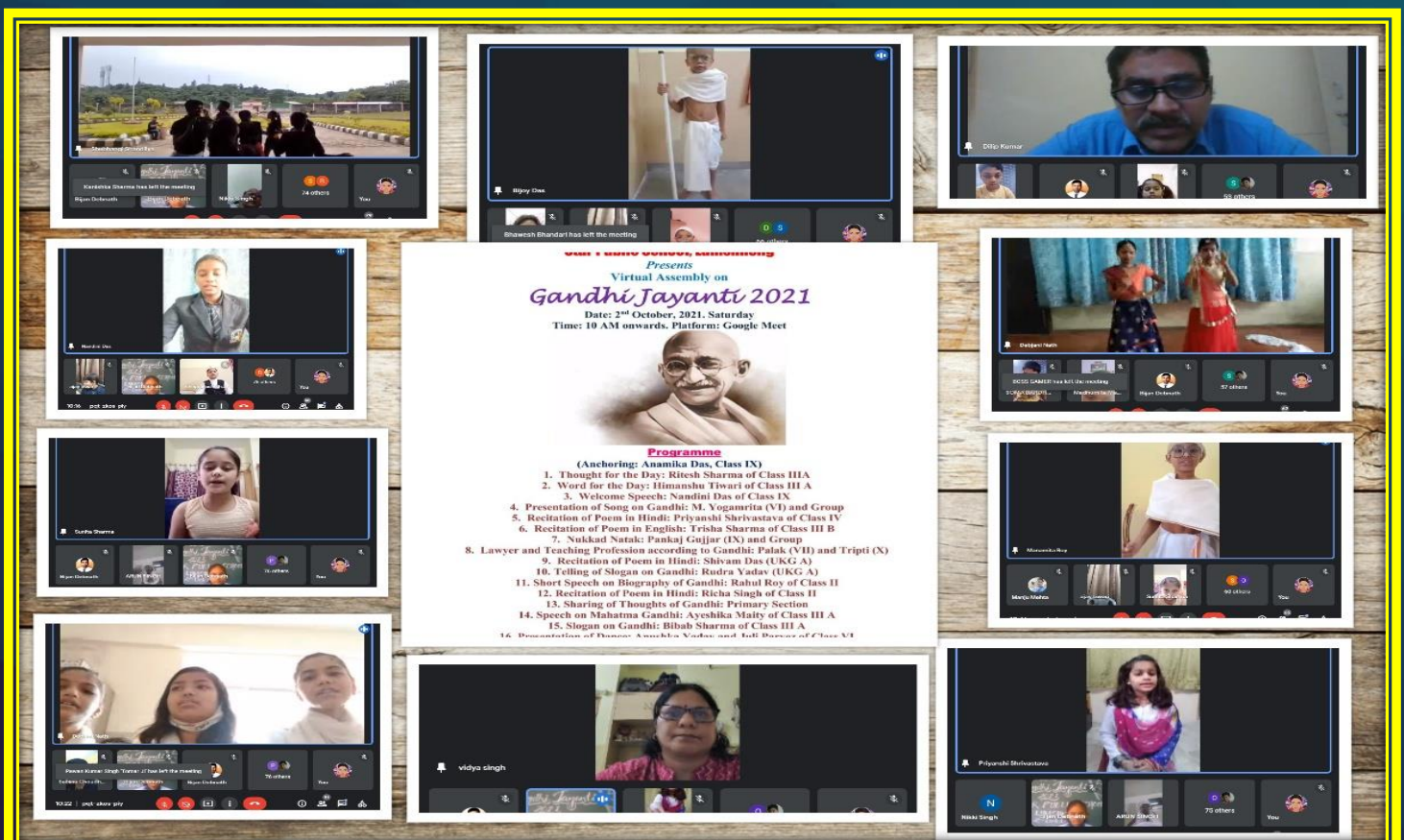

Twenty of our students, from class LKG to class XII, had actively participated in this contest to showcase their talents in the field of colouring.

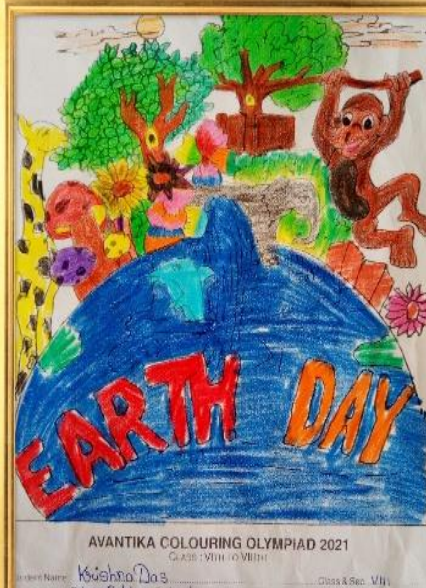

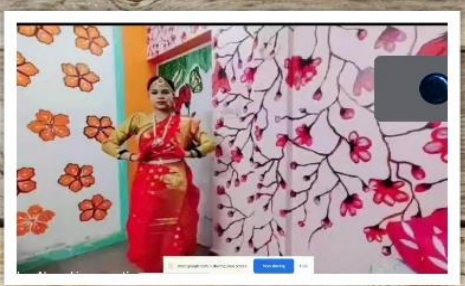
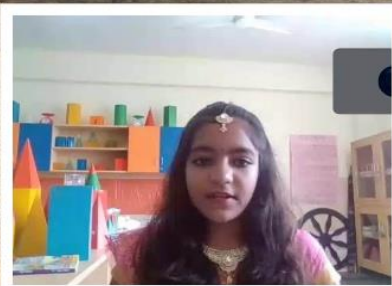
Durga Puja




Science Film Festival Quiz



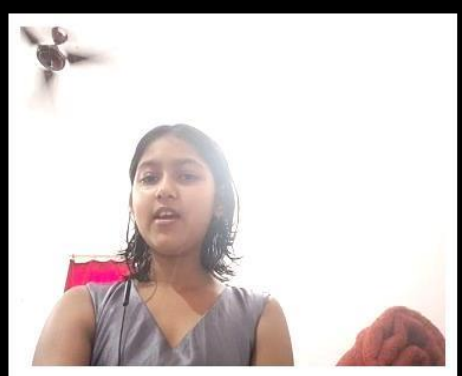
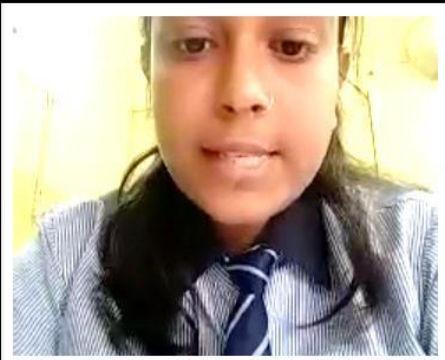
BETTER HEALTH THROUGH BETTER UNDERSTANDING
