On behalf of the entire team at Star Public school, I am pleased to present the Academic Performance report of the school.

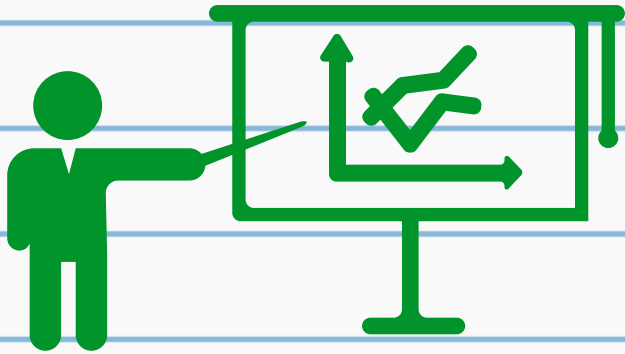
This report focuses on the School's academic performance in recent years. Centering on the instructional outcomes of the school, this report provides information on where do the students stand.



We measure the academic performance of our students and schools primarily based on the performance in the board examination results, Student learning gains: the improvement in Reading and Mathematics achievement with a focus on learning for every student every day.

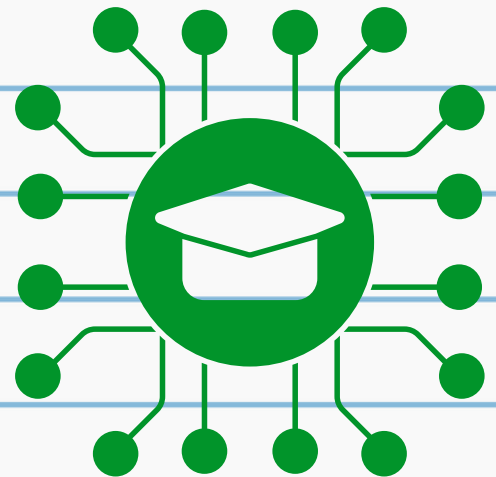
Our first batch (2019) of class 12 had 3 students which rose to 16 in (2022) with 100% pass percentage. Students excelled in their board examination and secured 20% more than their performance in class X board results. Out of 38 students graduated from Star Public School are pursuing their higher studies in Delhi University, NEHU & Assam Down Town University. We got permission from CBSE to offer Science subject at Senior Secondary level in the year 2020 and 2 batches of Senior Secondary level students have successfully passed with 100% pass results.

Class X Results



Our first batch (2015) of class 10 had 17 students. We had 100% pass result under CCE pattern till 2017. Afterwards, in the Annual examination, we had 100% pass results. Good number students secured above 75% marks and above.

Our students are regularly participating in Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM), Mangahigh Mathematics, BRICS Mathematics, KAMP, Tudu Buddy, Aryabhata Ganit Challenge and are winners at National & International levels.



We are focusing on the improvement of reading at all levels and accordingly students are offered Reading Challenges and CBSE reading program at story weaver. We realize that the quality of a child's education cannot be measured solely by scores which by their nature do not assess students' conceptual thinking, their ability to do research and to evaluate and defend ideas, their skill at written and oral expression, or their success in collaborative or teamwork. We will participate in SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning), A competency based assessment for 3, 5 & 8. Initially may be for Std. V & VIII conducted by CBSE.

Our students have won various scholarship awards by Star Cement CSR, The Telegraph, and District Administration, Govt. of Meghalaya on the basis of their academic performance.

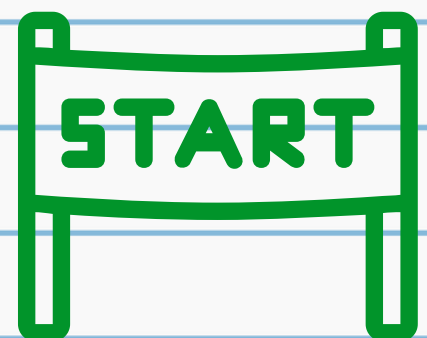
We have well trained qualified teacher as per CBSE guide lines. School encourages teachers to participate in In-service programs/ Teacher training and workshops conducted by various National Level organizations/ NCERT, Central Universities and CBSE.COE



To provide extra academic support to students, remedial classes are provided on regular basis.

These classes provide an opportunity of assistance to individual students through academic challenges and help to fill the knowledge gap and reinforce what they've learnt.

From 1st December extra classes and practice sessions have been scheduled to prepare students for board exams.

Children's Day Celebration

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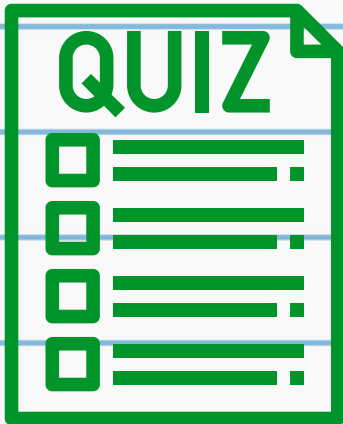

With such a vast arena of cultural events and fun filled activities, it



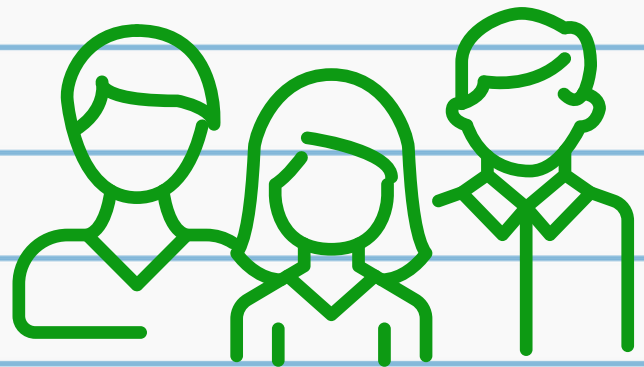

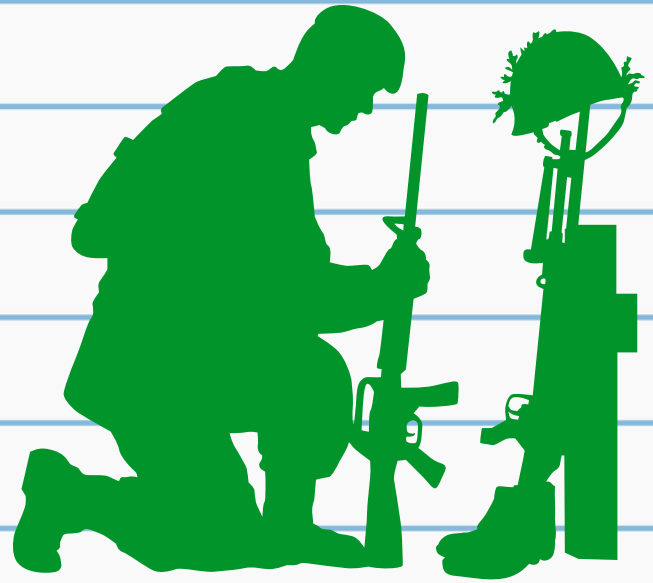


The team has qualified for the next round and is invited to participate in the Regional Round which will be conducted in offline mode on 14th December at Army Public School, Guwahati.

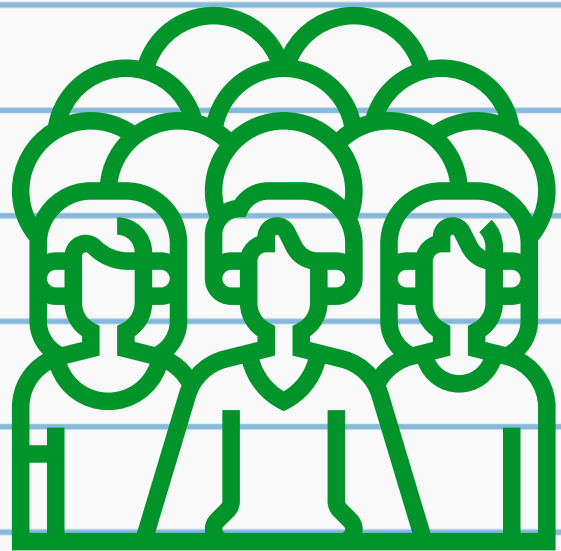

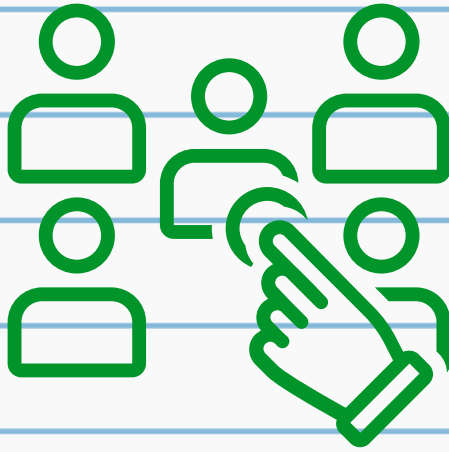

Saksham National Painting Competition

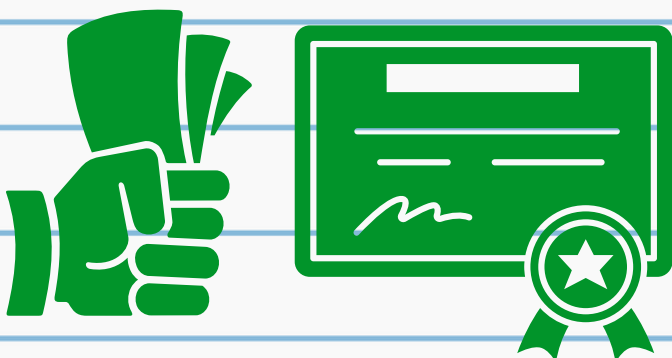

The Principal encouraged the students to abide by the Constitution and he motivated the students to reaffirm their commitment to uphold the ideology laid down in the Indian Constitution.





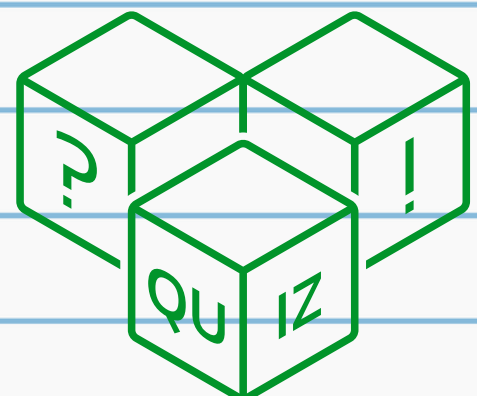
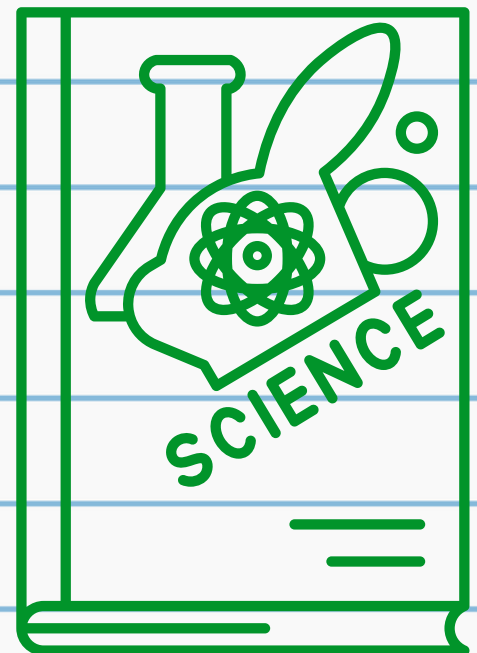
INDIA'S LARGEST SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH

Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan(VVM) is an initiative of Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA), in collaboration with Vigyan Prasar, an autonomous organization under the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India and National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), an institution under the Ministry of Education.

VVM is a national program for popularizing science among school students of standard VI to XI, conceptualised to identify the bright minds with a scientific aptitude among the student community.

76 students from Star Public School registered and appeared for VVM Examination conducted on 30 th November 2022.
