

Industrial Visit To Star Cement



Educational visit to industries provide an opportunity for students to see and experience real workstations, plants, machines, systems, assembly lines, and interact with highly trained and experienced personnel. The students learn about company policies in terms of production, quality, and service management and acquaint themselves with the working of instruments during the course curriculum. To help the students get an insight on these and how cement is being produced in the plant, Star Public School organized an educational industrial tour on 10/04/2023 for the students of Grade VIII to X.

88 students accompanied by 4 faculty members were part of this much awaited industrial visit. The trip was led by the Principal, Mr. K. Dilip, and Mrs. Neetu Bansal which began at 9.45 a.m. and at the foremost they reached 3rd Khub Mines, the Safest mine in the Nort-East. Mr. Ankur Rathore, i/c Mines, SCL, explained the process of mining and how slicing is done to obtain High-Grade limestone and the waste soil is consumed in the plant as an additive resulting in zero wastage. Further, he explained the process of blasting, etc.

Thereafter, the students were taken to the CCR, the Process Department and the students were explained how crushers are used to reduce the size of limestone to 200mm, segregated into high-grade and low-grade minerals by hoppers and grinders by the quality department. The entire process of cement manufacturing was explained by the Unit Head, SCL, Mr. Laxmaia Munjala. The Industrial visit to Star Cement provided the students with an opportunity to learn practically through interaction, working methods and an insight on live working industry.
