

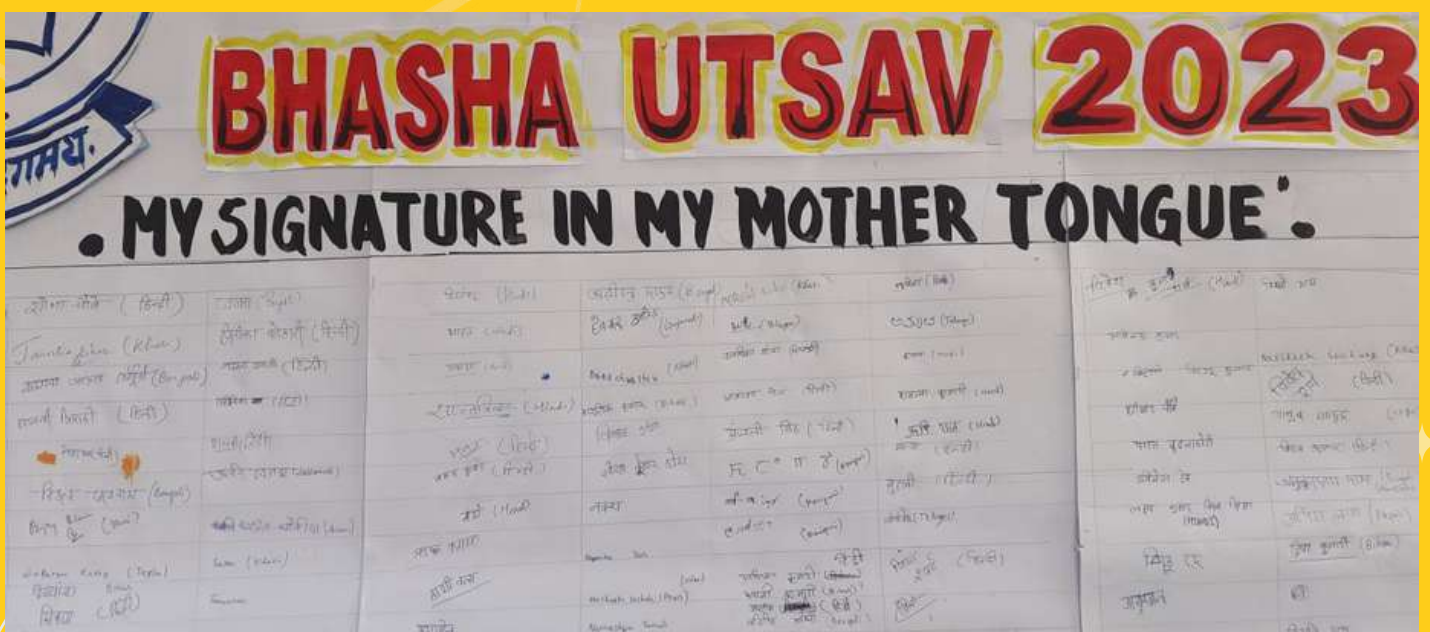




## 4. Bharatiya Bhasha Utsav

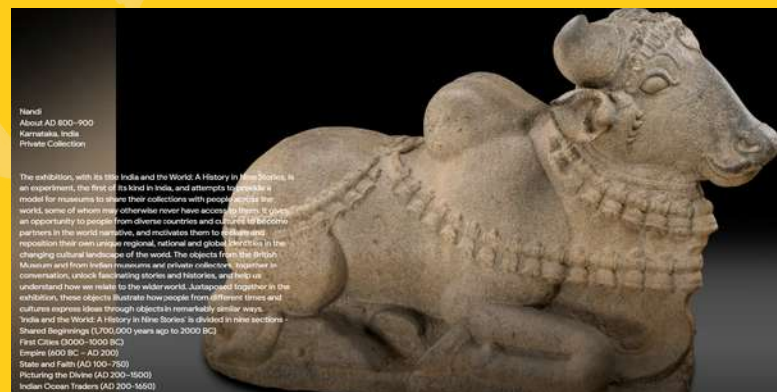

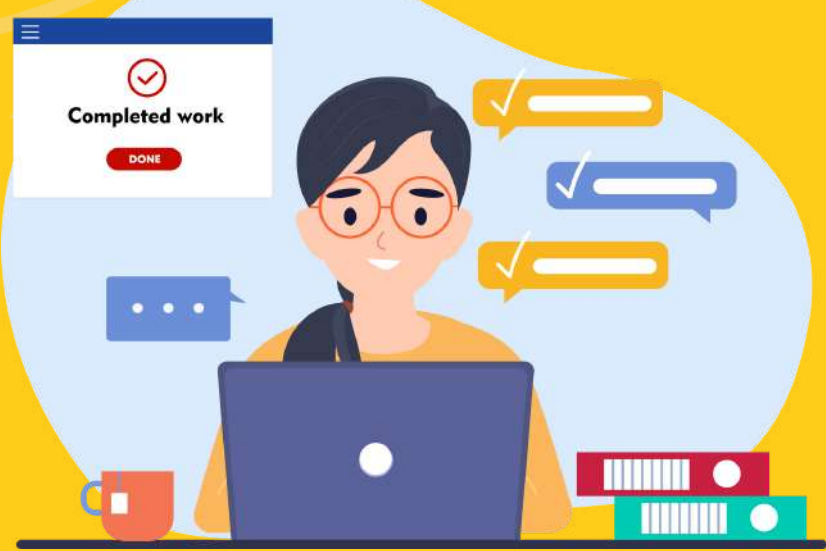
