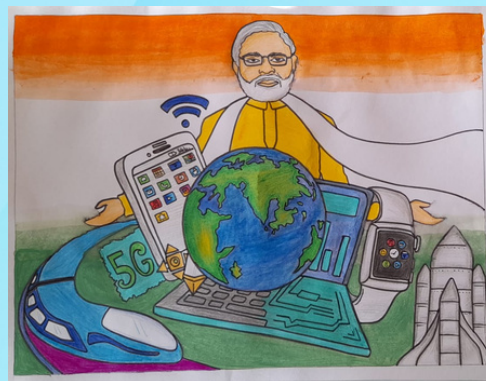

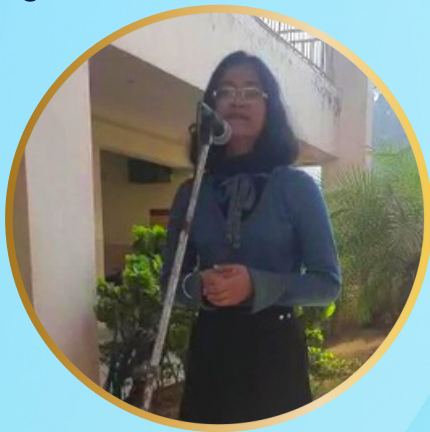


SCHOOL PICNIC & FAREWELL OF CLASS XII
