National Youth Day

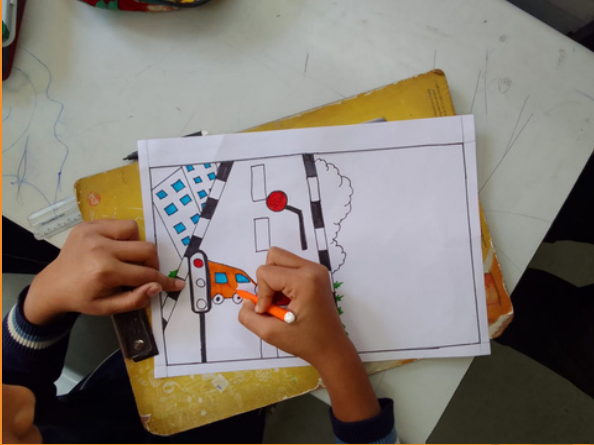

Observance of Road Safety Week

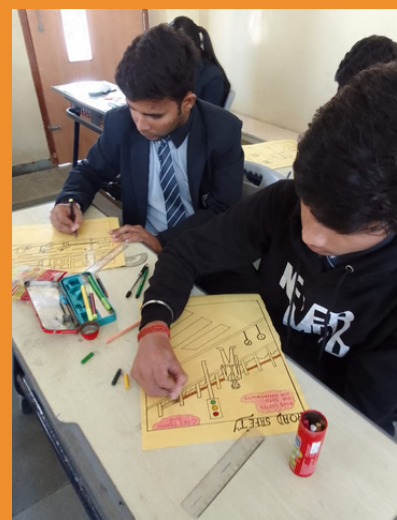
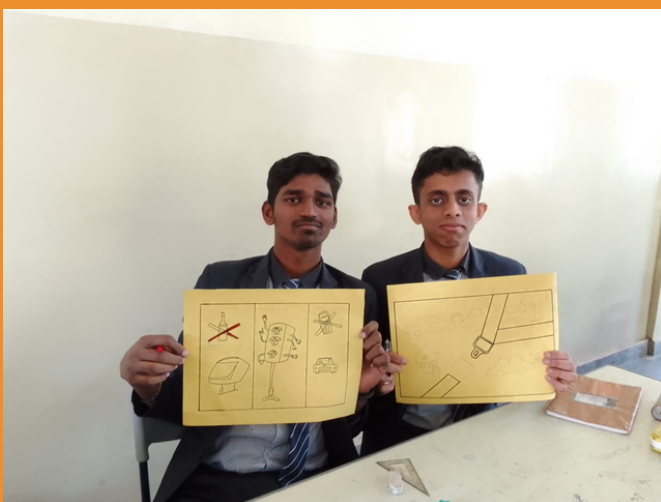
In order to decrease road fatalities, both the Central Government and State Governments are working in the area of road safety.

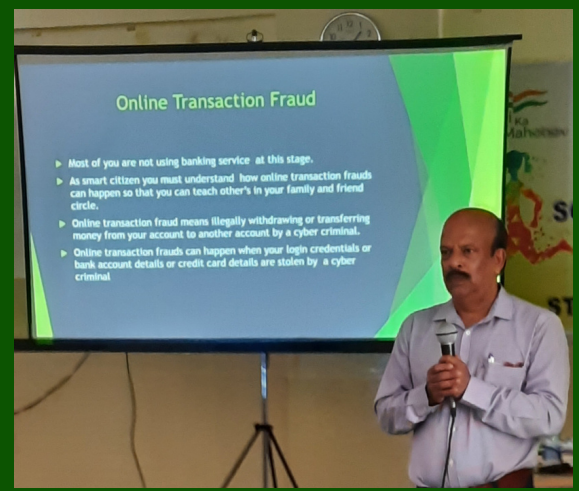
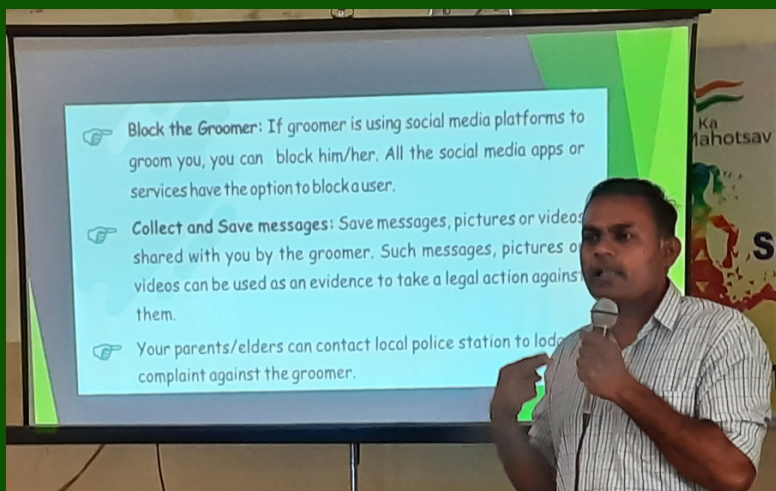


Stay Safe Online Campaign

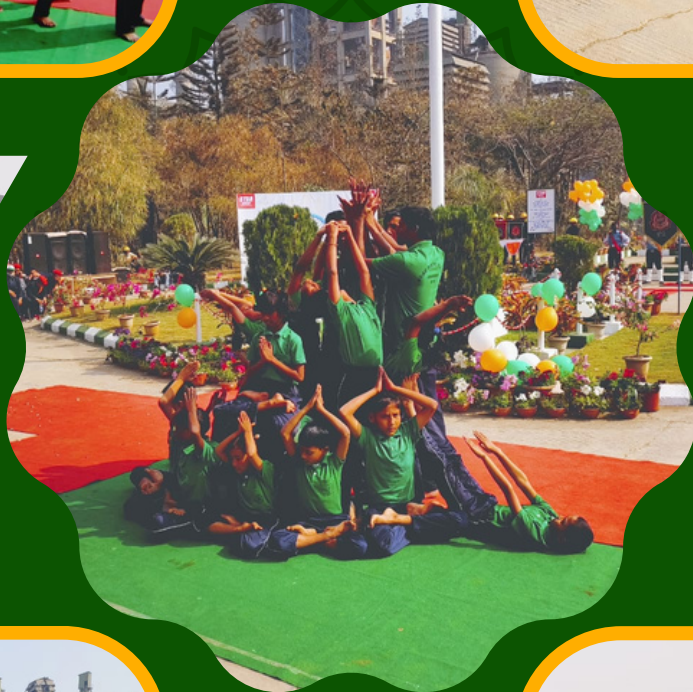

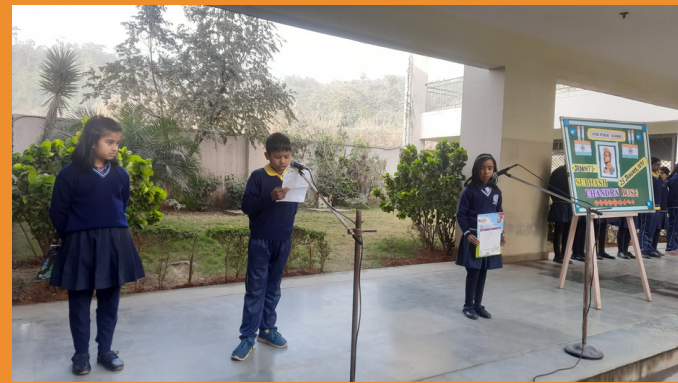
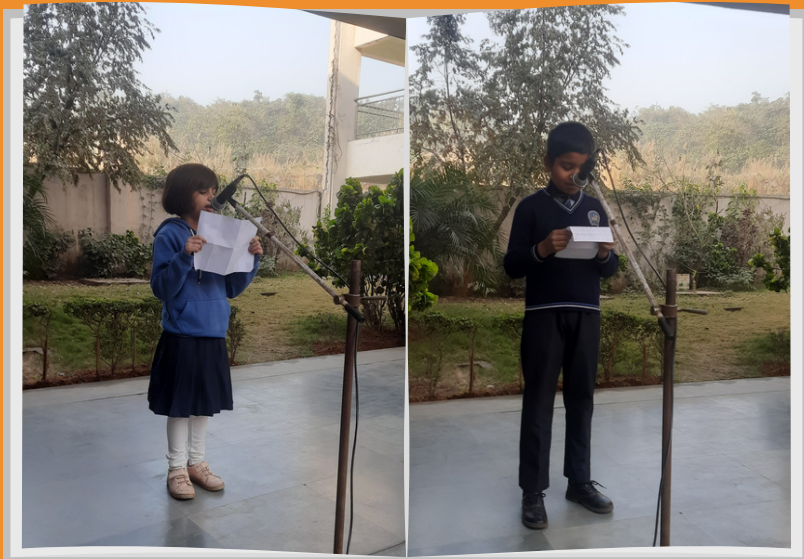
Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Jayanti

GSP is a meaningful environment education programme. It helps schools audit their use of resources and map their consumption and wastage. The exercise involves collection of information under the following heads:

Air

Helps schools understand how their transport policies affect air quality and to find ways of reducing their emissions so that a citizen's right to clean air is protected.

Energy

Audits the sources of energy, the consumption of energy; and explores ways in which this resource can be saved, to minimise pollution and costs.

Food

Helps your school to coordinate, implement and monitor its canteen to provide good-quality and nutritious food. The section will encourage students to be more conscious of the kind of food being promoted and consumed.



Land

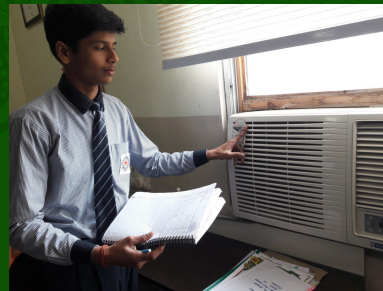
Focuses on the land-use of schools to map green areas, to identify biodiversity; and to grasp the enormous ecological and economic value of this resource.

Water

Helps build an understanding of water use, on the sources of water, on the ways of water conservation (rainwater harvesting and water recycling), the importance of sanitation facilities, with the ultimate aim of building a water literate and prudent society.

Waste

Helps in finding out the total amount of waste that is generated, and offers ways and means to reduce it by segregation, recycling and reuse. Star Public School submitted GSP Audit. The results will be announced in February and all green schools will be invited to New Delhi for GSP Carnival and Awards Ceremony on February 21, 2023

Brief Write ups on G20



The G20 was founded in 1999 after the Asian financial crisis as a forum for the Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors to discuss global economic and financial issues. As you are aware that the Central Bank in India is known as the Reserve Bank of India. As a premier forum for international economic cooperation, G20 plays a vital role in shaping and strengthening global architecture and governance on all major international economic issues. G20's role as international forum was recognized through its initiatives for economic and mutual cooperation of member countries and the Group of Twenty was strengthened and upgraded to the level of Heads of State and during the global financial crisis of 2007 and got designated as the 'premier forum for international economic cooperation'. This makes G20 truly an international organization for economic cooperation among its member countries.

G20 comprises 19 countries and an organization of countries known as the European Union as members. The members of G20 are: Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Türkiye, United Kingdom and United States and the European Union. The countries are from across the world and these members represent around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the global trade, and about two-thirds of the world population. This is why G20 is an important organization from the current economic, political and socio-cultural contexts as every country endeavors to enable themselves to economic develop and be a self-sustaining country in the context of globalization.

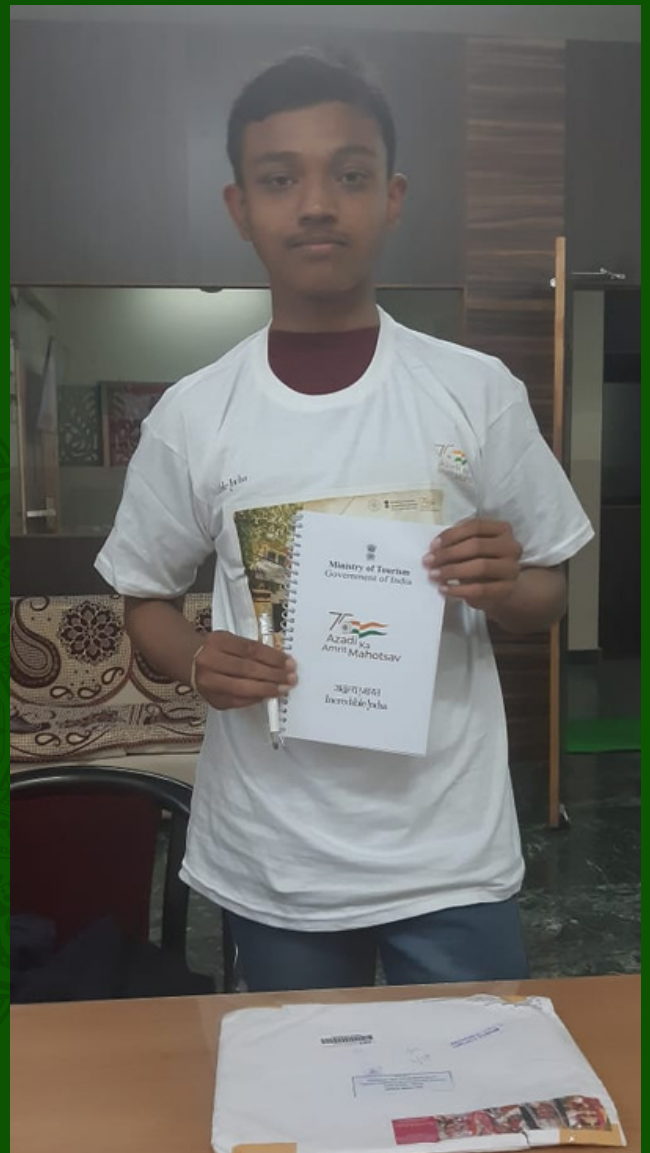

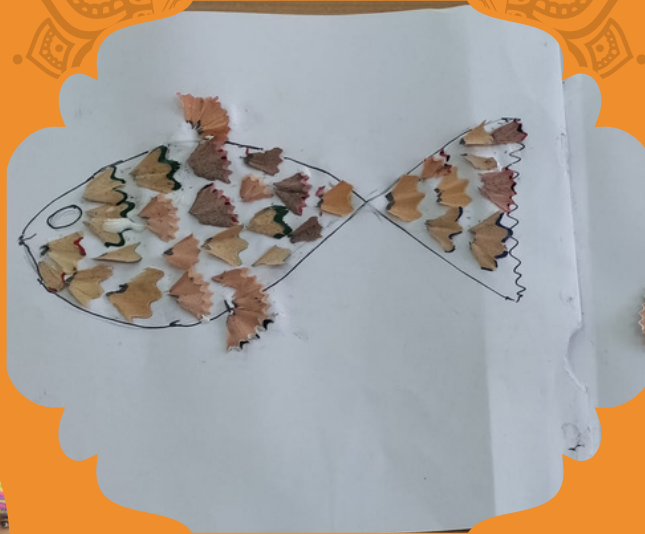
