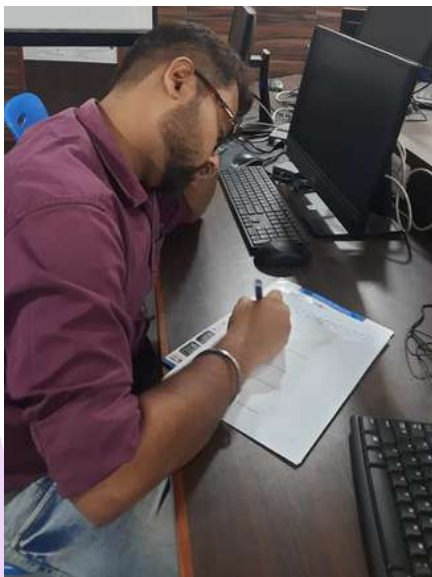
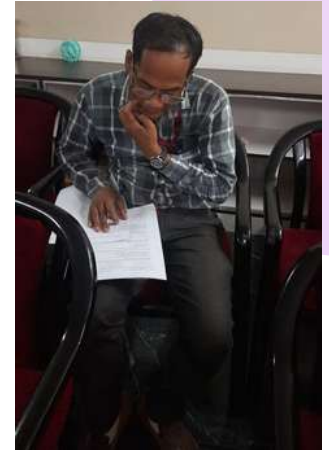

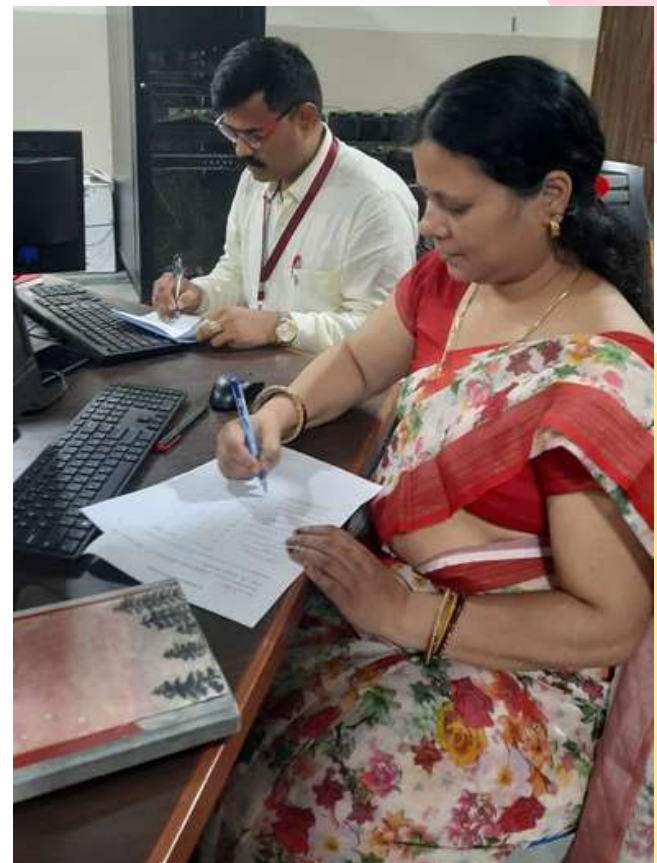
1. Project-Based Learning and Classroom Culture

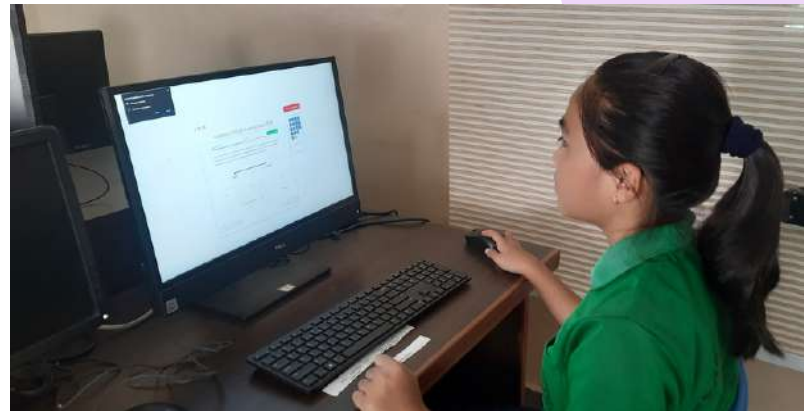

7. Critical Thinking Test by LogIQids and Education World

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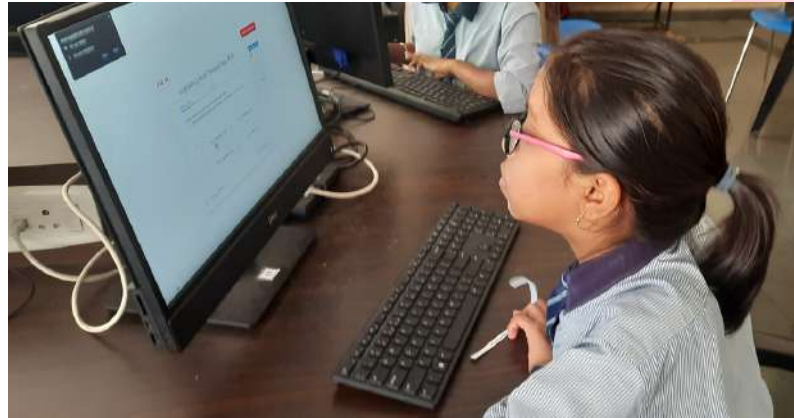
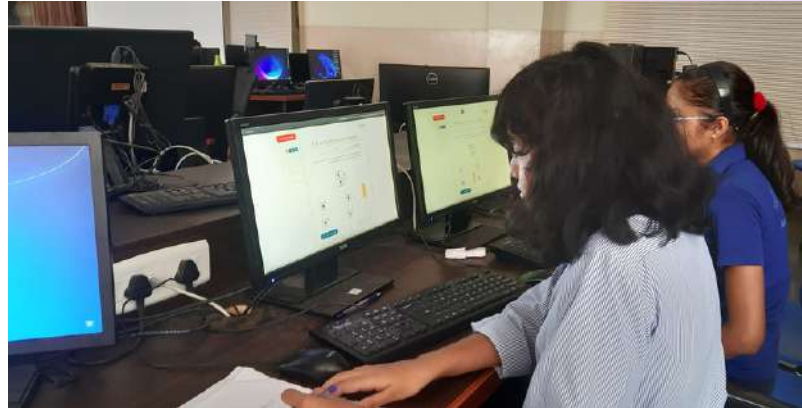

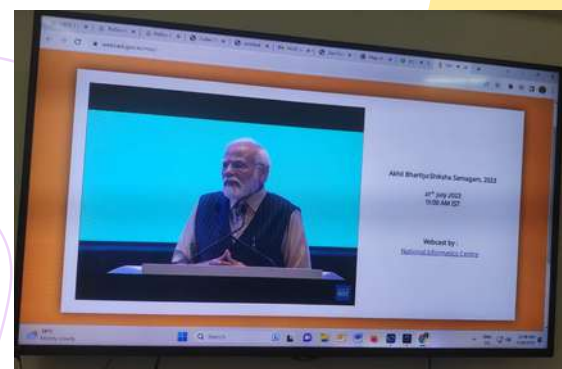


12. Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Samagam
