


Mr. Vineet Tiwari was equally fascinated by the jobs being undertaken by the school and he congratulated and appreciated Principal and his team for being at the top of the world.





Webinar on Hill Architecture

The Star Public School in Lumshnong had the privilege of hosting a captivating webinar titled "Designing and Building in the Hills: Traditional and Modern Techniques for Hill Architecture in India" on 6th May 2023. The webinar was jointly conducted by Mostafizur Rahman, an esteemed Associate Professor and Professor Nagendra Narayan at the Lovely School of Architecture and Design, with the aim of providing valuable insights into the challenges and opportunities associated with Hill Architecture.



The webinar commenced with an introduction by Mostafizur Rahman, who emphasized the significance of Hill Architecture in the cultural and historical heritage of the region. He expressed his desire to inspire Senior Secondary school students to explore and appreciate the rich architectural legacy of the Hills while also gaining an understanding of the Design and construction practices employed in these challenging terrains. The session began with an overview of the unique challenges faced in Hill Architecture. Mostafizur Rahman highlighted the importance of considering factors such as the topography, weather conditions, and geological characteristics of hilly areas. He stressed the need for architects and designers to adapt their approaches to these specific conditions, ensuring the sustainability and resilience of structures in hilly regions.



The webinar delved into the exploration of traditional building techniques employed in hill architecture. Mostafizur Rahman shared valuable insights into the use of local materials, such as stone and timber, and how they have been traditionally utilized to create sturdy structures that withstand the test of time. 


The happiness was clearly seen with a big smile on the children's faces after receiving these valuable items.



The Impact of Technology on Society: Students were asked to illustrate how technology has transformed our lives and work, as well as the potential future impact of technological advancements.





Sustainable Technology:


Participants were invited to create posters highlighting how technology can contribute to a more sustainable future, emphasizing concepts such as renewable energy, recycling, and green transportation.


