1. EDUCATION WORLD INDIA SCHOOL RANKING - 2023


Education World in association with C fore conducted the Education World India School Rankings (EWISR) 2023. To compile EWISR 2023, 11,458 sample respondents — educationists, principals, teachers, SECA (socio-economic category A) parents and senior school students — in 28 cities countrywide were interviewed by 118 C fore field researchers over a period of four months (June-September 2022). The annual EWISR is the world's largest schools ranking survey.




2. NIST SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH



It encompasses students from approximately 1,50,000 schools in India where English serves as the primary or secondary language of instruction. It is estimated that this initiative will engage with approximately 1.5 crore students across the country, along with their teachers and parents, resulting in a total outreach of about 4 crores nationally.


