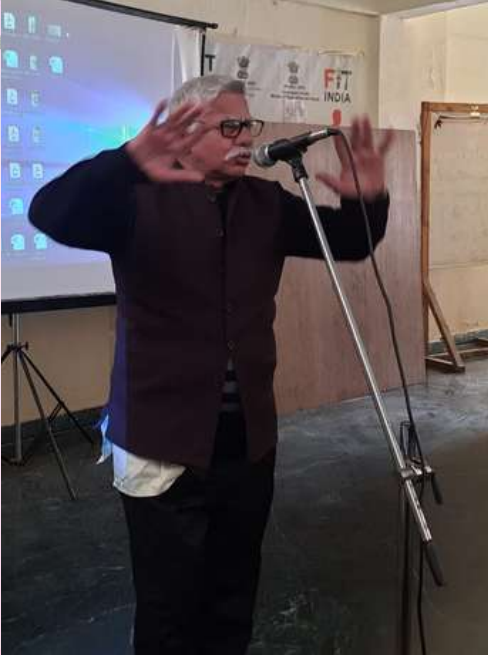

# Hindi Olympiad

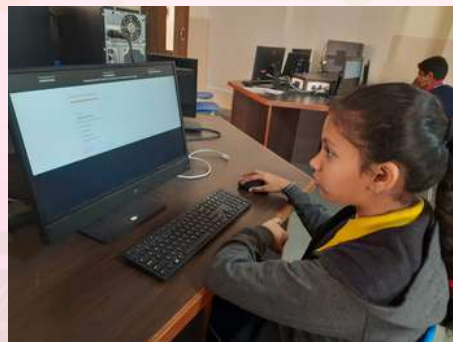
